Graduation Requirements

1. In order to receive a high school diploma, a student must satisfy the requirements established by the State Board of Education.
2. A diploma will be issued to each student who meets the requirements of credits, essential skills and attendance for graduation.
3. A modified diploma, extended diploma, or alternate certificate of attainment will be issued to students who meet the applicable requirements established by the State Board of Education.
4. A student who takes more than four years to earn the required credits shall be held to the requirements that were in effect when the student entered the ninth grade.
