# \$96 Million in 1992

\$58.6 million for 6 new schools

Clear Lake\*, Yoshikai, Crossler, Houck, Leslie\*, Stephens

\$37.4 million

- 43 classroom additions at 10 elementary schools
- 12 classroom additions at Walker Middle School
- 8 new portable classrooms at 4 elementary schools
- 6 new portable classrooms at McKay
- Major remodel at Parrish Middle School
- Repair/Renovation/improvements across the district (schools only)

# \$177.8 Million in 1998

\$111.3 million for 10 new schools

Forest Ridge, Hallman, Hammand, Harrit, Lamb, Lee, Miller, Weddle, Claggett Creek, and West Salem High School

\$66.5 million

- Construct ½ gyms at 7 middle schools
- 8 classroom addition at Grant ES
- Built Roberts High School
- 26 new portable classrooms
- Remodels/improvements across the district (schools only)

# \$242.1 Million in 2008

\$122.4 million for 4 new schools

Battle Creek, Chavez, Kalapuya, and Straub Middle School

\$119.7 million

- Repairs and renovations across the district (schools only)
- 22 new portable classrooms

What was not included in the 2008 bond:

- Career and Technical High School
- 7 Elementary Schools
