Salem-Keizer Public Schools wants to make their buildings bully-free so all kids can learn in a place where they feel safe and welcome.

No HAZING:

Forcing someone to do something either directly or through peer pressure that might hurt him or her in order to join a popular group or club.

No HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION, MENACING OR BULLYING:

Hurting someone on purpose at school, near school, during a school activity, on the bus or at a school bus stop.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Hurting a person's body, belongings or mental well-being.
- Making a student feel unwanted or unsafe at school.

No CYBERBULLYING:

Using a computer, cell phone or any other form of electronic communication to hurt someone's feelings or friendships. If this is done away from school, but makes a person feel unsafe either physically or emotionally at school, it is not allowed.

No DISCRIMINATION:

When others are judged because of their looks, color, religion gender identity, sexual orientation or actions.

No SEXUAL HARASSMENT:

Any unwanted sexual talk or touch, asking for or sharing nude images; sharing personal information meant to embarrass an individual, or a form of pressure to share one's body.

You are not alone.

Salem-Keizer Commitment:

All students and school staff members should be respectful. Bullying, harassment, menacing and cyberbullying are not tolerated by anyone.

Anyone can report bullying to a trusted adult at school. Reports can be anonymous.

Tell a trusted adult at school if you or someone else is being bullied or threatened.

When any adult at school gets a report about bullying, the matter will be treated seriously and handled appropriately.

Students who break bullying, harassment, menacing, sexual harassment, intimidation, discrimination or cyberbullying rules will face consequences.

If someone hurts, bothers or threatens a person because they made a report, they will face consequences.

If someone falsely reports bullying, harassment, or threats just to get another person in trouble, they will face consequences.
