



## Construction to start Early at Hoover!



In May 2018, voters approved a bond to fund improvements across the entire school district. Hoover will receive about \$4.8 million in bond-funded improvements!

The timeline for construction at Hoover has been moved up, so construction will start sooner than originally planned. Hoover is now set to begin work during Spring Break 2020. Construction is estimated to take between nine and 12 months to complete. Starting earlier means that we can expect construction to be finished earlier, and Hoover will receive the benefits offered by the bond soon!

To celebrate the start of construction, Hoover will hold a groundbreaking ceremony sometime this Spring. Keep an eye on our newsletter for more information about the celebration!

Since work is set to begin during the school year, some school operations will need to be adjusted to accommodate construction and ensure the safety of students, staff and visitors. The district's Construction Services department is currently managing active construction at four schools and is very skilled at facilitating construction and school operations.

To accommodate full-scale construction, the Hoover campus will be closed during summer 2020. The campus will be considered a "hard hat zone" and summer activities that normally happen at our school will be relocated. It's too soon to know what all the adjustments will be for our summer activities, but we will be sure to share the information as soon as we have it. We do know however that our school office will be relocated to Chávez Elementary School for summer hours.

When construction is complete, Hoover will have four new classrooms, a new secured vestibule at the front entry, a cafeteria expansion, a new multipurpose fitness room, upgrades to the electronic badge access system and more.
