NUTRITION SERVICES 2021

The Nutrition Services building is located in Southeast Salem and serves as the district's central kitchen and food distribution facility providing meal services to students. Improvements planned include expanding the kitchen and docking area, renovating the reception area and updating the electronic badge access system.

DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER 2021

Also known as LPC, the District Administrative Center provides office and meeting spaces for Safety & Risk Management, K-12 Education, Community Relations & Communications, Disciplinary Services, Human Resources, Financial Services, Translations and the Office of the Superintendent. Improvements planned include HVAC improvements, interior renovations, site improvements, window replacements and security enhancements.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES 2023

The Transportation Services building is located in Northeast Salem and provides office space and the mechanical shop for student busing and district fleet vehicle services. Improvements planned include HVAC improvements, interior renovations, site work and electronic badge access system installation.

REPROGRAPHICS 2023

The Reprographics Department is part of the district's Auxiliary Services and provides design, printing and distribution services for all district schools and departments, as well as external customers. Improvements planned include interior renovations, seismic improvements and electronic badge access system installation.

SUPPORT SERVICES CENTER 2022

The Support Services Center provides office space for the district's Special Education, School Nursing and Counseling programs. The district's board room is also located in this facility. Improvements planned include HVAC improvements, site work, flooring replacements, interior renovations, window replacements and electronic badge access system upgrades.

PAULUS BUILDING 2023

The Paulus Administrative Center provides office space for instructional support departments and programs such as the Office of Behavioral Learning, English Language Acquisition K-12 and Title Program Support. Improvements planned include HVAC improvements, site work, flooring replacements, interior renovations, window replacements and electronic badge access systems upgrades.

TECHNOLOGY & INFORMATION SERVICES 2023

The TIS building houses the district's student information, human resources and finance data systems and servers. It also provides office space for TIS staff members. Improvements planned include HVAC improvements and constructing a new back-up data center at McKay High School.
