

# At school and under construction

## Important information for Sumpter parents

Welcome back to school! Construction at Sumpter began in the summer and is expected to be complete early in the fall of 2022.

Sumpter will be an active construction site during the school year. Sumpter can operate safely while under construction because of careful planning and expert project management by the district and construction teams.

Safety is the top priority for students, staff, parents and visitors while the building is under construction. The contractor has set up fences around campus to help keep everyone safe.

Here is some important information to keep in mind during construction:

- Obey all signs and stay out of the construction zones!
- Don't distract construction workers – allow workers to focus on their jobs to help keep themselves and others safe.
- Please use extra caution when walking, biking or driving near the school and watch for construction vehicles.
- Construction includes relocating both covered play areas to make room for the new classrooms and cafeteria. A large tent will be used as a temporary covered play area during construction.
- Renovations inside the front entry are almost complete. Work will continue on the new transaction window for the office during the day and will be finished within just a few weeks. Temporary walls inside the building will block doorways leading into the construction zones.

The school office was relocated for the summer but returned to Sumpter on August 31. Please call the school office at (503) 399-3337 for questions about office hours.

Construction can cause some temporary disruptions, but the improved learning spaces for students are an important investment and the results will soon outweigh the inconvenience.
