



Claggett Creek Middle School Bond Construction Update!

Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Claggett Creek Middle School will be receiving upgrades in 2020 to give a boost to science education and improve safety and security in the building.

Highlights of the work happening at Claggett include a roofing replacement, repurposing select existing general classrooms into two science labs, library media improvements, a cafeteria expansion and more. Just over \$3.6 million will be invested in improvements at Claggett!

The district's project management team is currently working through the design process and preparing to bring a contractor on board to manage the construction at Claggett. Construction is planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and is expected to be completed over the summer.

Construction fences and the contractor's portable offices will be seen at Claggett as we get closer to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community's support of the 2018 bond, Claggett will soon have a safer learning environment with more space to support science education.
