



Grant Community School Bond Construction Update!

February 2020



Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Grant Community School will be receiving upgrades to improve safety and security in the building, enhance special education support and protect public investment in Grant’s facility.

Highlights of the work happening for Grant include converting select classroom spaces into two medical developmental learning classrooms (MDLC) with associated support spaces, ADA renovations to two existing restrooms, heating/ventilation system improvements, minor kitchen/cafeteria improvements, music room improvements as well as improved bus loading zone for the MDLC spaces.

The district’s project management team is currently working through the design process and preparing to hire a construction contractor. Construction is planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and is expected to be substantially complete in just three months.

Construction fences and the contractor’s portable offices will be seen on site at Grant as we get closer to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community’s support of the 2018 bond, Grant will soon receive important updates to the learning environment.
