



Scott Elementary School Bond Construction Update!

February 2020



Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Scott Elementary School will be receiving upgrades to relieve overcrowding and improve safety and security in the building.

Highlights of the work happening at Scott include ten new classrooms, a new cafeteria and kitchen, a new multipurpose fitness room, a secure vestibule at the front entrance, removal of all portable classrooms, heating/ventilation system improvements and much more.

The district's project management team is currently working through the design process. P&C Construction has been hired as our construction contractor. Construction is planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and is expected to be completed early in the fall of 2021.

Construction fences and the contractor's portable offices will be seen on site at Scott as we get closer to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community's support of the 2018 bond, Scott will soon have a safer learning environment with more space to support our students.
