



## Weddle Elementary School Bond Construction Update!

Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Weddle Elementary School will be receiving improvements in 2020 to increase safety and security and protect the public's investment in the school's facility.

Highlights of the work happening at Weddle include a roofing replacement, music room improvements and expanded wireless capacity. Weddle will also receive safety improvements such as intercom system upgrades and electronic badge access system upgrades. Over \$1.1 million will be invested in improvements at Weddle!

Construction and improvements are planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and are expected to be completed over the summer.

Construction fences and the contractor's mobile office will be seen on site as Weddle gets close to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community's support of the 2018 bond, Weddle will soon have an improved learning environment.
