



Whiteaker Middle School Bond Construction Update!

February 2020



Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Whiteaker Middle School will be receiving upgrades in 2020 to give a boost to science education and improve safety and security in the building.

Highlights of the work happening at Whiteaker include roofing improvements, repurposing one general classroom into a science lab, a gym floor replacement and improvements to the front office space to increase visibility and control of the front entry. Just over \$2.1 million will be invested in improvements at Whiteaker!

The district's project management team is currently working through the design process and preparing to hire a construction contractor. Construction is planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and is expected to be completed over the summer.

Construction fences and the contractor's portable offices will be seen at Whiteaker as we get closer to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community's support of the 2018 bond, Whiteaker will soon have a safer learning environment with more space to support science education.
