

Update on Bond-Funded Construction at Cummings February 2020



Construction improvements funded by the 2018 bond are on schedule to start at Cummings at the end of the school year in June.

Our project management team at the district’s Construction Services Department has been working hard to finalize plans, hire a contractor, and plan the schedule and phases of construction work.

Before the end of the school year, we’ll see contractors start staging activities like setting up construction fencing and temporary portables as office space on site.

Construction at Cummings is planned to be substantially complete by the end of summer. During the summer, the campus will be closed to staff, students and visitors. **For safety, the entire campus will be considered a hard hat zone and only construction crews will be allowed on site.** Our school office will be relocated to Gubser Elementary School for normal summer hours. We’ll have more information for you as we get closer to summer.

When construction is complete, Cummings will have an expanded cafeteria/multipurpose space, a secured vestibule at the front entry, a paved pedestrian pathway along Delight Street, seismic improvements, an updated electronic badge access system, and more!
