



Cummings Elementary School Bond Construction Update!

Construction season is gearing up in Salem Keizer School District. Many schools are currently under construction, including Cummings, and a total of 20 schools are expected to be under construction within the next couple of months. Just over \$1.9 million is being invested improvements at Cummings, thanks to the bond that voters passed in 2018.

While schools are currently closed and many businesses are in different stages of reopening because of the coronavirus pandemic, the governor’s “Stay Home, Save Lives” order allows construction businesses to operate provided they implement social distancing policies. Our construction contractors are fully informed about the requirements of social distancing.

When construction is complete, Cummings will have an expanded cafeteria/multipurpose space, a secured vestibule at the front entry, a paved pedestrian pathway along Delight Street, seismic improvements, an updated electronic badge access system and more!

Construction began in May and is expected to be completed over the summer. Our campus is closed to visitors – Please do not enter fenced areas and obey all posted signs.

Cummings’ office will be relocated to Gubser Elementary School during the summer. Campuses will remain closed, and the schedule for staffing the school office will vary during the summer. Please contact Cummings’ office at 503-399-3141 for information about summer office hours.
