



## Weddle Elementary School Bond Construction Update!

May 2020



Construction season is gearing up in Salem Keizer School District. Many schools are currently under construction, and a total of 20 schools are expected to be under construction within the next couple of months, including Weddle. Just over \$1.1 is being invested improvements at Weddle, thanks to the bond that voters passed in 2018.

While schools are currently closed and many businesses are in different stages of reopening because of the coronavirus pandemic, the governor’s “Stay Home, Save Lives” order allows construction businesses to operate provided they implement social distancing policies. Our construction contractors are fully informed about the requirements of social distancing.

Highlights of the work happening at Weddle include a roofing replacement, music room improvements and expanded wireless capacity. Weddle will also receive safety improvements such as intercom system upgrades and electronic badge access system upgrades.

Construction is planned to begin in June and is expected to be completed over the summer. Our campus is closed to visitors – Please do not enter fenced areas and obey all posted signs.
