

COVID-19 Specific School Arrival Visual Screening Process

Visual screening

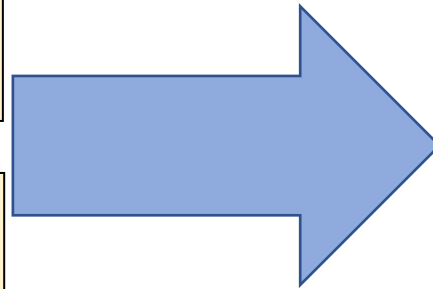
(observation only)

- Unusual coloration (flushed or pale)
- Unusual behavior (behavior change, lethargy, unusual fatigue)
- New or significant coughing
- Respiratory symptoms not typical for student
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- Appearing ill
- Vomiting

Student Complaint

(verbal report)

- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Headache
- Muscle pain
- Fever
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- General unwell feeling



FULL SCREENING REQUIRED BY TRAINED STAFF

(SBHA, trained back up staff, School Nurse, Nurse Help Line)

- Student will be escorted (while maintaining physical distancing) to isolation for full screening by trained staff.
