## Highlights of planned improvements and expansions

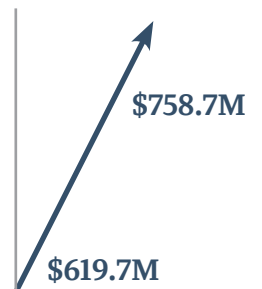
<b>170</b> new general education classrooms	<b>39</b> new or renovated science labs	<b>22</b> cafeteria additions or expansions

## Growth of the bond program

Thanks to premiums and interest earned on bond proceeds, grants and reimbursements, the total approved bond program has increased to nearly \$758.7 million without affecting the taxpayer's levy rate. This means the district is returning more improvements to the taxpayer than originally promised!
