First day of school start dates

**All schools will start one hour late on Wednesdays to give school staff a regular time for collaborating and planning support for students.*

Volunteer opportunities

All volunteers must complete a criminal history background check prior to beginning their volunteer service in order to help protect the safety and welfare of all students and staff.

Registration & Enrollment

Families can register their students online using ParentVUE or by contacting your child's school for help.

If you have had a student attend school at Salem-Keizer Public Schools, then you already have an existing ParentVUE account. If you have never activated your ParentVUE account, your school can provide activation information.

There is a three-step process for registering your student:

1. Identify the school your student(s) will attend by calling our Boundary Information Line at 503-399-3246 and giving them your child's home address.
2. Provide immunization records and documentation for proof of age and home residence to register your child.
3. Register your child by contacting the school.

Bus rider eligibility & registration information

Students are eligible for bus transportation if the student lives at a residence within their neighborhood school and the residence is outside the walking zone for that school. The walk zones are 1.0 mile for elementary students and 1.5 miles for middle and high school students.

Bus rider registration can be completed during the online registration or enrollment verification process through ParentVUE. If you need assistance with completing online registration, please contact your child's school for assistance in verifying your bus rider registration.

The district will finalize bus routes and times by late August. Information will be available in ParentVUE or contact the Transportation department at 503-399-3100.
