**2021-2022 External Customer Rates**

Re: 2021-2022 Transportation Rates

The rates for buses, drivers, and shop time have been established for the **2021-22** school year. The new rates will go into effect on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

**SHOP:**

Hourly Rate: \$ 102.71 per hour

**BUSES and DRIVERS (TRIPS):**

Bus Rate: \$ 1.58 per mile  
Van Rate: \$ .83 per mile  
Driver Hourly Rate: \$ 47.11 per hour  
Driver Overtime Rate: \$ 70.67 per hour

**OVERNIGHT TRIPS:**

Meals and Lodging: Overnight trips generally incur costs for meals and lodging, according to the GSA per diem rates.  
Driving Time: Drivers are to have a set schedule, including time off the clock, per Commercial Driver License requirements.

**OTHER INFORMATION:**

Drivers are paid from Transportation back to Transportation. Any trip in excess of 4½ hours entitles the driver to a duty-free meal period. Teachers and coaches are asked to work with drivers to establish a mutually agreeable time for the driver's duty-free meal break that will not inhibit service to the school activity. No meal reimbursement is necessary; driver's time is paid straight through in lieu of meal reimbursement with the exception of overnight trips. Field trips are restricted to specific travel times. Transportation Dispatch can help locate contract operators for needs during bus route hours.

When renting a bus, the parties understand their responsibility to assume costs of repairs in the event of damage.

An agreement with these rates is enclosed. Please sign and return at your earliest convenience.  
When your agreement is returned, I will sign it and return a fully-executed copy to you.
