Salem-Keizer Public Schools seeking applications for district budget committee

Candidates for the two open positions will be interviewed and appointed by the school board

SALEM, Ore. – Salem-Keizer Public Schools is seeking two community members to serve on the district budget committee. Each appointee will serve a three-year term ending June 30, 2024. Committee members will review and approve budgets for adoption by the school board during this time.

Candidates must be registered voters and residents of Salem-Keizer School District 24J. A specific geographical location in the district is not a legal requirement, but the school board prefers to maintain a representative balance from all areas of the district. Salem-Keizer Public Schools employees, officers or agents are not eligible to apply.

Candidates will be interviewed and appointed by the school board at the regular business meeting scheduled for **Tuesday, March 8, 2022**.
