Salem-Keizer Public Schools adjusts academic calendar for the 2021-22 school year

November 12, 2021 will now be a non-student day

SALEM, Ore. – The district has announced that **Friday, Nov. 12 will be a non-student contact day, meaning there will be no online or in person learning. There will be no need for students to make up the day** as SKPS continues to meet the required instructional hours.

Nov. 11 is Veterans Day and a scheduled school holiday. Because Veterans Day falls on a Thursday this year, the district has a unique opportunity to support the well-being of staff and students by allowing a longer break in instruction.

The district is working with current child care partners to offer child care at some sites. Families should check in with their child care provider to determine locations. In addition, SKPS will provide lunch meals at a limited number of sites. More information regarding meal service will be shared the week of Nov. 1.
