## Emergency Preparedness Overview

Emergency preparedness and operations are coordinated and overseen by the district's Safety and Risk Management Services department. The systems focus on protection, prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery following FEMA's emergency management practices.

Safety and Risk Management Services also maintains professional working relationships with several community partners focused on emergency response, and preparedness such as the City of Salem, Marion County, and the State of Oregon. These partnerships increase communications across a multitude of different agencies and allows Salem-Keizer Public Schools to be a partner in the community in the event of a widespread emergency.

In the event of a large event such as a Cascadia subduction zone earthquake Salem-Keizer Public Schools would coordinate with Marion and Polk County Emergency Management offices in conjunction with the State of Oregon's Unified Command Center, coordinating services through FEMA. Salem-Keizer Public Schools would be a member of the overall emergency operations center under the direction of the Oregon Office of Emergency Management. The focus is to develop situational awareness of operational needs and critical services to the community.

All schools have individualized emergency operations plans. These plans provide guidance, resources, and instructions to school leadership in the event of emergency such as a natural disaster. This includes specific plans that provide evacuation procedures, meeting locations, maps, and instructions for both actual events and drills.

Each school has an earthquake kit with first-aid supplies, and emergency rescue equipment (inventory of earthquake kit attached). The district also has additional resources kept in reserve such as bottled water, and personal protective equipment that can be distributed in the event of an emergency or natural disaster.

Students receive at least 30 minutes of monthly instruction on fire, life safety, earthquake dangers, and drills. Over the course of a school year, schools conduct ten evacuation drills, with two of those drills focused on our earthquake response procedures.

During an earthquake, students and staff are instructed to drop, cover, and hold on to reduce the chance of being struck by a falling object. Once the shaking stops, staff and students will evacuate the school in accordance with each schools' plan outside in a safe area away from the building. An earthquake would also trigger the activation of our emergency operation center.

The emergency operations center is structured using the Incident Command System (ICS), which is a standardized approach to the command, control, and coordination of emergency responses. The emergency operation center would bring staff from several departments together to assist schools in the management of the plans and to ensure appropriate resources are used to reduce risk exposures to our students and staff.
