Ready Schools Safe Learners Updates

V 6.4.2 Revised April 2, 2021

- Revised physical distancing requirements
- Revised cohorting requirements
- If county metrics move to a more restrictive threshold, schools are not required to shift to more restrictive educational model
- Outdoor, stationary mask breaks are allowed



Physical Distancing and Cohorting

- The physical distancing guidance has shifted from 6 feet to 3 feet
- Does not change our current hybrid schedule, but does give flexibility for classroom setup and movement in classrooms
- Cohorts up to 36 students are recommended; removed 100 max
- 6 feet will continue to be the threshold of close contact for exposure determination, most common spaces, and when eating
- With a few modifications, these changes create a pathway for 5-day/week in-person instruction Fall 2021



Planning for Fall 2021-22 and EDGE

- Planning assumption is for a 5-day/week model at all brick-and-mortar schools following safety protocols.
- EDGE will be an option for families who prefer a digital platform. Registration window for EDGE is currently open through May 14.
- **EDGE Independent** and **EDGE Connected**
- Families who register during this window are guaranteed a spot in one of the EDGE programs.



Summer School Update

- SKPS will hold **summer programs at all levels.**
- **Every school** will offer a summer school option.
- **Summer school will be on site** and focus on engagement and unfinished learning.
- Student Services received their summer work experience grant again **so we can hire some amazing youth** to help with tasks.



Summer School Update

- Elementary is primarily July 7 – 23.
- Middle School programming primarily August 2 – 20.
- High School programming is throughout the summer.



Summer School: What to Expect

- **Elementary**
 - Focus on academics, social emotional, learning recovery
 - Indoor and outdoor learning, summer libraries etc.
- **Middle School**
 - Example – 3-week intensive program at Leslie MS
 - Hands-on learning, high energy and engagement.
- **High School CTEC**
 - “Boot camp” for incoming students with “skill up” hands-on opportunities
 - 9th and 10th grade orientation and culture-building events
